Dear Pastor Shorter and New Testament Baptist Church,

Let me start by saying thank you for all of the birthday wishes, cards, gifts, and love offerings that were sent to Connor, Angie, and myself in October. Your thoughtfulness made our birthdays even more special. It's hard to believe that Connor is 20 years old! Seems like only yesterday we were bringing him home from the hospital and now he's graduated high school and studying in an apprenticeship to be a Sparky (that's what the Aussies call an electrician).

We continue to see visitors at church from time to time, although the past few weeks have been quiet with no new visitors. Our regular folks continue to be faithful and have a heart for reaching the lost.

Recently, we had a Sausage Sizzle outreach in Augusta. A "Sausage Sizzle" is a popular Aussie thing to do in the summer. Basically, they grill meat sausages (similar to hot dogs) and put them on a bun with grilled onions and barbeque sauce, mustard, or ketchup. They charge anywhere from \$3-\$5 each and people love them. We set up a grill and gazebo outside of the local IGA grocery store and gave away 150 sausages with a gospel tract, as a way of meeting people and inviting them to church. It went really well, and we had several people who seemed interested in visiting. Please pray that we might see visitors, and that through this, souls might be saved.

I've mentioned Steve and Peg in past prayer letters. Steve is saved, but Peg is not. They have a friend named Ivy (in Mandurah) who turned 100 years old this past Tuesday.
