We are so thankful to you all for continuing in prayer for our family as we finish up our furlough. It's been a sweet time of fellowship with our families and our church family. The children have enjoyed participating in the children's ministries of our home church and making memories with their cousins, aunts and uncles, and grandparents. We don't take for granted the opportunity to come back for this time. It's been a spiritual refreshment for our family and a time of refocus for our family, our marriage, and the ministry.

We are still scheduled to return to Thailand on March 19th, Lord willing. Right now we are in the process of applying for visas for our two youngest children who were born in Thailand. Because they were born in Thailand they didn't need a visa. But once they left the country they needed one to get back in. Once we return they will be able to be placed under my documents as dependents of mine. Please pray for the process of our return. It's not as simple as it used to be pre-covid. As it stands right now we will need to guarantine for 10 days in a government approved hotel after we return. If we test negative multiple times throughout that time period then we will be able to continue on to our home in Mae Sai. The requirements change, it seems, weekly. So we will definitely know more once the time gets closer.

We had a blessed Christmas and New Years here in the states. It wasn't exactly as we expected as our family came down with THE virus. We are glad to be on the other side and are thankful it wasn't more severe. THANK YOU to those of you who blessed our family with generous Christmas gifts. We feel overwhelmed by the goodness of God to our family. And He has used so many of you to do that!

This week I will be flying to Texas with my two older children for a few meetings. The day after we return we will begin our trek down to North Carolina and Florida for some meetings as a whole family. We look forward to reuniting with old friends along the way as well as meeting a few new churches. It's a blessing to us to be able to share what God has been doing in Mae Sai.

Please pray with us that God would prepare the hearts of the Thai people before we return, especially those who have already heard the Gospel. We look forward to reuniting with the people there and to keep sharing Christ.
