*Dear Praying Friends*

It's been nearly two months since we returned to Thailand and we couldn't be happier to be back. While we were stateside we prayed that God would be at work in hearts even while we were away. We know that God doesn't NEED us, but that we are privileged to be tools that He will use. He can do great things, even while we are on the other side of the world! We have seen specific answers to prayer and are rejoicing in what God is doing even now.

We had a period of adjustment as we settled back into our home and reconnected with people. Alyssa and the kids have a routine down and we are getting into a new school year with our oldest two. Gideon is in first grade and Chloe is in second grade. Things in our home are quite busy right now with five children, seven and under. We are thankful for the job that God has given us to point these five children to Him. It's not one we take lightly! Our oldest three have been enrolled in Taekwondo and it's already been a great opportunity to meet people in the community. They are also keeping busy studying the Thai language 3-4 hours each week.

One of the ways that God has specifically answered prayer is with Boss. You might remember that in the past he was translating for our Sunday Bible study. It was a struggle for him to balance the changes in his family life and his commitments elsewhere and he began to pull away. God has been at work in his life while we were away and he is showing an excitement for the things of the Lord that I haven't seen before. He is initiating Bible study, spiritual growth conversation, and fellowship. We have resumed a Sunday Bible study with Boss translating for the lessons. As much as it's a blessing to have someone to translate for me, the ideal thing is for the lessons to be taught exclusively in Thai. It creates continuity of thought and allows twice as much material to be taught at a time. Boss has agreed with excitement to study the lesson with me during the week and then teach it in Thai on Sundays. I am making good progress with the Thai language but it's another thing entirely to preach in Thai. This last Sunday was the first Sunday with Boss teaching and it lasted almost three hours. What a blessing! I look forward to seeing how God continues to work in Boss's life. Already his eyes have been opened to truth in several areas of doctrine.

One of the projects I am working on right now is an outreach project involving special tracts with QR codes that allow me to track the way people interact with the tracts. Each tract asks a different spiritual question and will give opportunity for further connection online or in person. Please pray that I could make connections with people that have spiritual interest. Boss is helping with the translation side of this project and I'm thankful for his help!

Another man, Gawt, found me recently through our English Center page on Facebook. He is a pastor of a church about 20 minutes out of town and he desires to practice his English and discuss spiritual things. When I asked him about when he came to Christ his response was that his family is Christian and that is why he is Christian. He agreed to do a Bible study and we just completed our second lesson. We have been praying for the villages surrounding Mae Sai and the Lord has brought an opportunity right to our door!

There is more that the Lord is doing here, but these are the highlights I wanted to share with you this month. I will include some other names to pray for as you intercede for the ministry here.
