May-June 2022 Prayer, Praise & Progress Report

Greetings! We declare “particularly what things God had wrought” among Filipinos by our ministry (Acts 21:19).

THRONE’S FACTUAL MANUAL: “All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: That the man of God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works” (2 Timothy 3:16-17). All members use the King James Bible for faith and practice.

TIME AND FOCUS ON THE MASTER: “...to walk in all his ways, and to love him, and to serve the LORD thy God with all thy heart and with all thy soul” (Deuteronomy 10:12). “We will walk in the name of the LORD our God for ever and ever” (Micah 4:5). “...sat at Jesus’ feet, and heard his word” (Luke 10:39). “That ye might walk worthy of the Lord unto all pleasing, being fruitful in every good work, and increasing in the knowledge of God” (Colossians 1:10). “...and truly our fellowship is with the Father, and with his Son Jesus Christ” (1 John 1:3).

TEMPERANCE (GODLY) FOLLOWERS MEEKNESS AND MERCY: “Put on therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, bowels of mercies, kindness, humbleness of mind, meekness, longsuffering” (Colossians 3:12).

TESTIMONY OF FIDELITY AND MATURITY: “...shewing all good fidelity...” (Titus 2:10). “I have written unto you, fathers, because ye have known him that is from the beginning. I have written unto you, young men, because ye are strong, and the word of God abideth in you, and ye have overcome the wicked one” (1 John 2:14). Members fidelity (faithfulness) to God’s Word, God’s house, God’s man is resulting in maturity (spiritual growth).

TEARFUL FULFILLED MEMORIES: “They that sow in tears shall reap in joy. He that goeth forth and weepeth, bearing precious seed, shall doubtless come again with rejoicing, bringing his sheaves with him” (Psalms 126:5-6). “And of some have compassion, making a difference: And others save with fear, pulling them out of the fire...” (Jude 22-23). “I have fought a good fight, I have finished my course, I have kept the faith:” (2 Timothy 4:7).

TEAM FISHING MENTORING AND MISSIONS: “And he saith unto them, Follow me (mentoring), and I will make you fishers of men (missions)” (Matthew 4:19). We are always investing in educational and evangelistic ministries: mentoring (members, students and pastors in training) and missions (evangelism and church planting).

Hungry children, aged women, crippled people, in the streets begging for food. It really does deeply sadden you when you see that this is a reality! Their tears of hopelessness and desperation.
