Myanmar Bible Distribution: God has answered your prayers in a powerful way! The container arrived at a good time for the weather and workers and despite many obstacles, we had no trouble sending most of the boxes down to Yangon. The remainder of the boxes are being stored here in Mae Sai for micro-shipments to churches in Northern Myanmar. I’ve already prepared or sent out five orders in the past ten days, as the requests multiply from needy churches. Please pray for good communication and wisdom as these Bibles are distributed throughout Myanmar. It’s great to see the light of God’s Word going forth into a country filled with darkness.



Outreach to Flood Victims: The rains have been very heavy this year, and many families near the river have had to evacuate their homes due to serious flooding. Our church has been helping some families from Myanmar that have been overlooked by the regular channels of flood relief. It’s been a blessing to give bags of basic food supplies, along with a Gospel witness, to a captive audience. This last week, it was great to have Anai (John) and his wife Bahn Ye (Joanna) join Bro. Luke and I as we shared the Gospel to a group of apartments next door to Gu Lin’s family. We are thankful for a special offering from our home church (LVBC) that allows us to expand and continue this outreach.



Church News: The new church building has been a great blessing! We are enjoying the extra space, and especially the ability to have activities for the kids upstairs during the adult Bible study. Please pray for the faithfulness of each church member as we try to balance the weekly responsibilities. Gu Lin has been attending the morning services and we are praying for the Lord to soften the heart of his wife to the Gospel. Both of them need to be saved, and we can see the Lord drawing Gu Lin closer to that point of repentance and faith in Jesus.

Visa Renewal & Travel Plans: Our volunteer certification letter came back in record time this year, allowing us to schedule our visa extension a few weeks early. That is a direct answer to many prayers. Thank you! With that said, we are making plans to return to the US at the end of October for two months to introduce Luke to family and reconnect with our home church.
