We are currently switching gears into travel mode as we prepare for a 2-month trip to the US to visit family. With that said, we are rejoicing in much answered prayer regarding the ministry here in Thailand.

Visa Renewal: We just received another year extension to our volunteer visas. Thank you for your intercession!

Visitors to Church: Ever since our move to the new building, we've been having some new visitors to our Sunday morning service. Please be in prayer for the following individuals:

- Gu Lin and his brother Gu Kant Gu Lin is close to salvation.
- Ku Maung Maung We witnessed to him several years ago and he just recently desired to come to church, seeking answers for addictions in his life.
- Jawm A young Shan man who has experienced oppression from evil spirts and is looking for help.
- Ku Nai Min and his sister Pyo Pyo Friends of John. They have some past experience with a Catholic church, but no real understanding of the Gospel.
- Royal and her family They are curious neighbors that have a desire to visit and learn English. They also have a Catholic background, which is rather unusual for a Shan family.



Gospel Outreach: We've had some great opportunities to share the Gospel with families from Myanmar this last month. Each Sunday night, Bro. Luke and I have led an outreach to flood victims and families struggling to meet daily needs. Every time we've had a captive audience to share about Christ. We've already been able to reach over 90 families with the Gospel in this way – most of which live less than 5 minutes from our church building. Please continue to pray for the seeds sown and for these individuals to read the book of Romans that they have received.

Church Requests: Please pray for continued faithfulness and unity among our church members. We trust that the Lord to give the right messages to Bros. Luke and Heaven as they together share the preaching and leading of the worship service over the next 10
