WE HAVE MOVED! Praise the Lord! We moved house on the 5th of December. The older I get the harder moving gets. I also wouldn't advise anyone to ever move house in the month of December, but we did and we're in, and Amen! We were able to get cheaper rent and a much smaller house just on the other side of the same neighborhood. Downsizing has been interesting but good, somebody had a lot of stuff, huh, wonder who? We are still unpacking and sorting and selling and throwing away and taking stuff to the "opp" shops. This house is owned by an investor who has a few rental properties so we should be safe to stay awhile, Lord willing!

We are looking forward to some stability and structure in everyday life. It's very stressing to live with the thought that you might be without a house from one week to the next, kinda keeps you from getting a sound sleep. You can get used to it but you never get comfortable living that way. Now multiply that by about 10 (I'm being conservative) and you can begin to imagine how my wife has felt for the last two years, :)! Thank you for all your prayers about our housing situation, they are greatly appreciated.

Now, health wise we are all well. Mrs. Trish Rowney had her cancer surgery and they did remove her lower lobe of her right lung. She is doing very well with recovery and so far has had no negative reports of any other sings of cancer. She does weekly physio to help her learn to pace herself while walking and breathing. She gets stronger each week and we have seen her a couple times in the services lately.

Mrs. Rose Harvey seems to be doing better with the migraines too. Please pray for our son Levi, he has a knee surgery coming up in the next few months. He injured it during family camp and then added to that injury later at work and completely tore his ACL tendon and a slight meniscus tear. He's on the waiting list now and we are praying that it would happen soon.

Satan certainly has been diligent lately to discourage and hinder the work here. We are coming up on the 1 year mark to when we lost two families last year due to the working of a spiritual wolf. We have been dealing with the fallout and the continued working of that person and sadly we just lost another husband and wife due to the same man and his false teaching. I diligently and often warned our folks to avoid and stop all contact as it would only lead to division and discouragement. I am praying this will be the end of it and we can begin to heal and move forward. Its taking a great toll on all but God knows and we are looking and trusting Him for wisdom and strength as we press on.

I have left Bro. Jarrod's picture on purpose so you can remember to pray for him as well please. His parents "required" him to go on a camping holiday up North for one week over Christmas. He didn't want to go because he knew there would be "situations" and "things" he wanted to avoid. Because he would not participate and dressed differently he became under attack from both his parents and other family. It was a difficult week and he left early because of it and now there is a big strain on his relationship with his parents, especially his mother. He's doing great with it all but he's torn because he has a great burden for his family. Please pray for him as he deals with the persecution from the ones he loves so much.
