Early in 2022 we were stateside finishing up a furlough when my Dad passed away unexpectedly. The grief was unlike anything I had experienced before and I'm so thankful that I could be with my mom and siblings during that very difficult time. God was gracious to us in many ways.

After we returned to Thailand in April we jumped headlong into the ministry. It was our first time away since we had moved to Thailand and it made us understand even more how our hearts were knit to this place and people. And we saw how God was at work here even while we were away. When we returned, Boss approached me and expressed renewed interest in studying the Bible and growing in His knowledge and understanding of Scripture. He has proven himself to be faithful and teachable and we have spent countless hours studying the Bible together. I praise God for how He has worked in Boss's life to bring him to Scriptural truth in many areas! Please continue to pray for Boss and for his wife, Neyney. They have some big spiritual decisions to make and we are praying that they would seek first the Kingdom of God.

There are some new developments in our building situation that I'm excited to share with you! For the last two and a half years we have been meeting in a building close to our house and it has been a blessing and a help in the ministry. We hold Bible studies there, teach English, and I also have a personal office where I can work without interruption. We have been praying for a place with better parking (our current building has room for a couple of motorcycles and one vehicle) and God provided even more than we could have asked for at the same price we were already paying! We have signed the contract on the new building and the landlord is willingly paying for a complete renovation and addition. Work has begun and we hope to move in by next month. This new building provides much more parking and also a large area outdoors for the children to play! God is good.

The Lord has provided many opportunities to share the Gospel with people in the last couple of months! Fu and Michelle continue to show great interest in the Gospel. Alyssa has been able to study the Bible with Michelle several times, clearly communicating the Gospel. Her husband, Fu, is very busy but I praise God for a few opportunities to speak with Him as well. Another man I'd like you to pray for is Duan. He is one of my English students and we've been developing a relationship with him for the past few months, showing the love of Christ and looking for an open opportunity to share Christ with him. There have been some recent circumstances in his life
